**NOTICE
EMERGENCY DROUGHT CONDITIONS**

In letters sent to our shareholders and customers in 2014, 2015 and 2016 you were notified that the State may restrict the use of water during drought conditions.

1. Residents must not use a hose to wash down sidewalks and driveways;
2. Avoid excess run-off when watering lawns, flower beds and gardens;
3. When washing vehicles, use a hose with a shut-off nozzle.
4. Decorative fountains can no longer operate unless they are equipped to re-circulate the water;
5. Residents must not irrigate outdoors during and within 48 hours following measurable rainfall.

Due to you, our shareholders and customers, your water company was able to achieve a 19% reduction in water usage based on usage in 2013.

THE DROUGHT IS NOT OVER

If the State restricts the use of water as they did in 2014, 2015 and 2016, we are asking our shareholders and customers to continue the practice of conserving water use until drought conditions are over.

1. Restrict the use of outdoor watering to 2 days per week between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. Do not water between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.;
2. Adjust sprinklers to a maximum of four (4) minute cycle;
3. Do not allow excess run-off on the sidewalks, driveways or into gutters;
4. Repair water leaks and report any leaks from water meters and fire hydrants to your water company staff as soon as possible;
5. Talk to your family and friends about the ways to save water. If everyone saves a little, we will all benefit.

With community conservation, your community and your water company will do its part to get us all through these drought conditions.

Finally, be vigilant. If you observe a water leak in the street, a leaking fire hydrant or excess water running in the gutters, notify your water company at the telephone numbers listed above.
